Veteran Cards can be used to access DVA-funded medical and mental health treatment, as well as prescription medicines in Australia. States and territories, and businesses may also offer concessions and benefits to Veteran Cardholders. More information can be found on DVA's website.

Veteran Card – All Conditions include cards printed with Totally and Permanently Incapacitated (TPI) and Extreme Disablement Adjustment (EDA), or War Widow(er). **Eligibility and concession levels can vary depending on the specific Veteran Card type and the organisation providing the concession.** Images above are provided for illustration purposes only. Actual cards may vary slightly depending on cardholder eligibility.

Tasmanian Seniors Card

The Tasmanian Seniors Card is free to join and provides cardholders with discounts from participating businesses and government services.

The Seniors Card is part of a national program. All state and territory governments issue their own Seniors Card, and the benefits vary. Generally, businesses (including tours, attractions, public transport and accommodation) in one state will usually recognise cards from another.

This card allows the holder to receive a free second ticket for their companion carer from participating businesses and organisations on presentation of card.

The Companion Card is part of a national program and can be used interstate. Generally, businesses (including tours, attractions, public transport and accommodation) in one state will usually recognise cards from another.

Housing assistance for community and public housing (including housing for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people).

Electricity

Annual electricity concession

The Tasmanian Government offers an electricity concession to help eligible low-income households reduce power costs.

Embedded network electricity (ENE) concessions

Available to eligible residents in embedded networks with individual electricity meters. Includes low-income, medical cooling/heating and life support concessions.

Heating allowance

The heating allowance is a twice-yearly payment towards full heating. Only one heating allowance per household, eligibility is means-tested.

Life support concession

Provides eligible customers with a discount on their electricity bills. The discount is applied by the customer's retailer at a cents-per-day rate. Rates are dependent on the device.

Medical cooling or heating concession

A daily discount to eligible customers who have, or live with a person who has a medical condition that requires the cooling or heating of their main home to manage the medical condition.

Adult travel concession

Concession fares are available on all public transport, including free travel for eligible cardholders.

Bass Strait Islands Age Pension Air Travel Subsidy

Age pensioners living on the Bass Strait Islands are eligible for a 50% rebate on one return trip to mainland Tasmania each financial year (1 July to 30 June).

Taxi Subsidy Program 50% concession

Eligible members receive a 50 per cent concession on taxi travel in Tasmania when using a Transport Access Scheme Taxi Subsidy Program Smartcard.

Spectacle Assistance Scheme

Up to 25 per cent reimbursement of out-of-pocket childcare costs is available for eligible TasTAFE students who need approved childcare to attend online or on-campus classes.

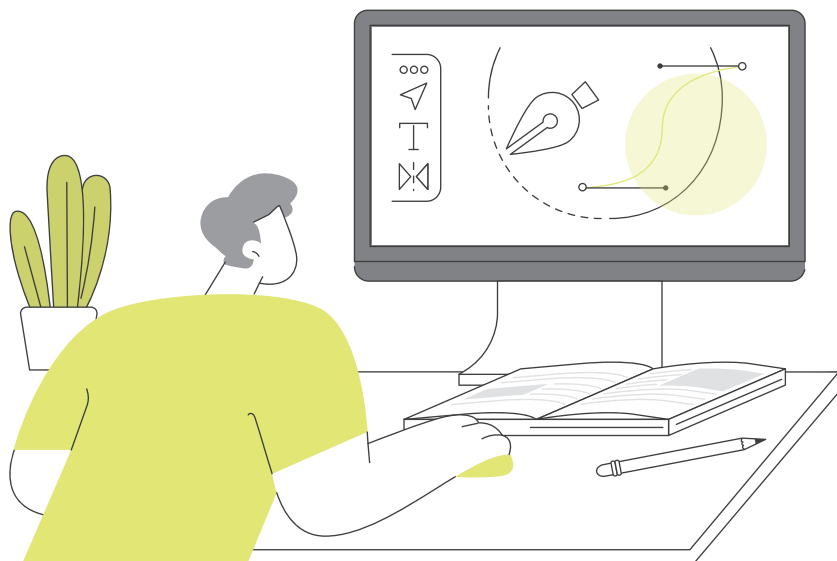

Subsidised emergency, general and denture services are available to eligible adults.

Continuous Positive Airways Pressure Program

Equipment is available for people clinically assessed with a sleep-related breathing disorder who require a positive airways pressure machine. Prescription from a sleep specialist required.

Subsidised nutrition may be available for eligible concession card holders assessed by a dietitian. Other funded or compensated supports may require referral elsewhere.

Home Oxygen Program

Oxygen supplies are available for patients assessed by a specialist as needing oxygen therapy, with approval required from respiratory medicine at the Royal Hobart or Launceston hospitals.

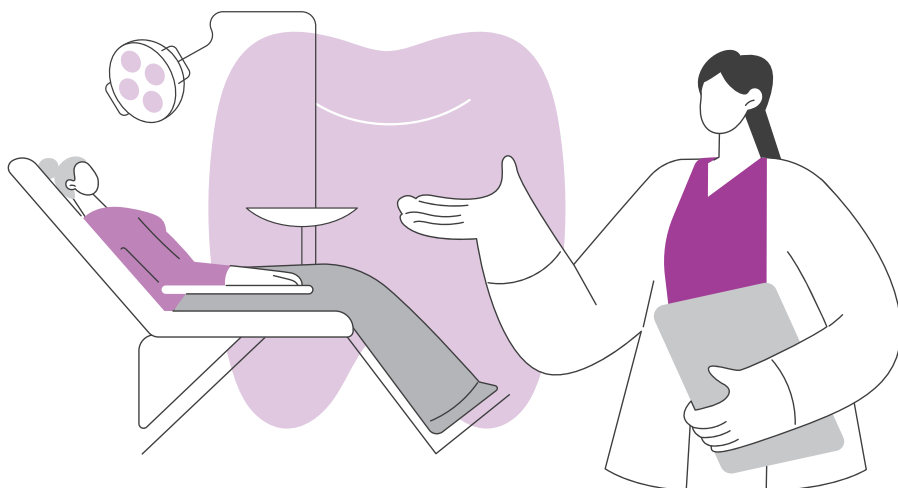

Exemption from duty on vehicle registration applications and transfers is available.

Exemption from duty on transfer, in certain circumstances, to shareholders on the winding-up or deregistration of a company.

Exemption from duty on transfer to a beneficiary of a deceased estate.

Exemption from duty on transfer from one person to another when there is a breakdown of a relationship.

Motor tax (40% rebate)

A 40 per cent motor tax rebate available for private-use goods vehicles such as up to 4.5 tonnes GVM, not used for trade or business purposes.

Motor tax (100% exemption)

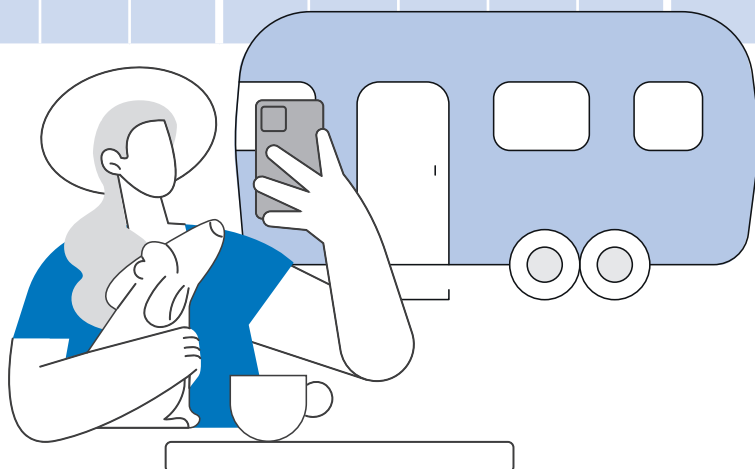
